What is JUMP?

JUMP, Juvenile Mentoring Program, is a program designed by Youth Opportunities Unlimited (Y.O.U.) specifically for students at Shaw.

You get to explore careers, learn how to land a job, practice drug-refusal skills, and qualify for placement in a job. JUMP is provided at Shaw by a Y.O.U. Career Coach. Best of all, JUMP is fun!

Your Coach

The Y.O.U. Career Coach is 100% dedicated to the success of every JUMP student.

A Y.O.U. Employment Specialist works with the Career Coach and with JUMP students to help prepare for success in a part-time or summer job.

JUMP activities

Many workshops and other activities are held at Shaw HS. The Career Coach is at Shaw HS Monday through Friday during the school year.



.The Career Coach is available for one-on-one help with homework and other academic concerns.

In addition, JUMP students go on field trips to employers, participate in community service, and can compete in Y.O.U. Youth Career Olympics. JUMP delegates attend the annual PRIDE Conference.

Make smart choices

Learn how to make smart choices that will help you succeed in life: including how to refuse alcohol and other drugs, how to communicate effectively with others, how to solve problems, and much more.

JUMP students learn leadership skills and apply these skills in community service and in peer-to-peer activities at Shaw HS and at a local elementary school.

Explore careers

Each year JUMP takes students on field trips to a few of the 300 employers we work with. In the 2007-2008 school year, students met with recruiters and learned about real job openings and careers at Progressive Insurance, Cleveland Hopkins Airport, and other employers.

Succeed in school

JUMP students receive academic support during group sessions and in one-to-one sessions. We help you build the skills that help you advance to the next grade and to graduate from high school.

Learn valuable workplace skills

In workshops you learn how to land a job. Mock Interviews will prepare you for the real thing.

You'll also learn job-survival skills, work ethics, effective communication, and the things that matter most to employers.

Workshops on topics such as team-building, decision-making, and problem solving will help you keep the job once you land it.

And next summer

By participating in JUMP, you prepare to qualify for placement in a summer job in summer 2009. Y.O.U. placed 40 JUMP students in a summer job in 2008.
